## BLUEWATER PLAYOFFS

Note: Short season and lack of refereeing availability does not allow all ten teams to host regular season games. Host sites have been selected by a combination of school desire to do so, who has 'missed a chance' to host in recent years, and field availability. The following Preliminary BAA Playoff venues were chosen to give two more schools the potential to host a day of rugby. However, due to 'seeding' from regular season play, those teams may not be home playing that day. Therefore the actual #2 seed will then be given the chance to host. It is important

**CWOSSA Qualifiers for Sports with North and South Divisions**  
(other than volleyball)

**“A/AA”**

1. BAA Champion receives berth to CWOSSA

Two Entries

- the team that advances the furthest in the playoffs will gain the first berth
- a. If the first entry is gained by a south school:*
  - the second furthest advancing south school plays against the furthest advancing north school

If teams from the same division advance to the same point in the playoffs, refer to the tie breaking formula:

- b. If the first entry is gained by a north school:*
  - the second furthest advancing north school plays against the furthest advancing south school

If only one north school makes the playoffs the second furthest advancing north school will be based on league play

If teams from the same division advance to the same point in the playoffs, refer to the tie breaking formula:

- c. If the furthest advancing “A/AA” schools from the north and south finish at the same point in the playoffs, the CWOSSA berths will be determined in the following way:*
  - 1<sup>st</sup> north vs 2<sup>nd</sup> south
  - 1<sup>st</sup> south vs 2<sup>nd</sup> north
  - the highest ranked school will be the home team

This situation would only occur if a north and south “A/AA” schools lost in the league semi-finals and there were not any “A/AA” schools in the league championship game.

For example:

Tie Breaking Formula

1. highest finisher in the league
2. record in head to head games
3. points for/against in head to head games
4. points for in head to head games

### **CWOSSA Qualifiers for Sports with North and South Divisions**

(other than volleyball)

“AAA”

1. BAA Champion receives berth to CWOSSA
- the “AAA” school that advances furthest in the playoffs gains the berth to CWOSSA

if teams advance to the same round in the playoffs refer to the tie breaking formula

Tie Breaking Formula

1. highest finisher in the league
2. record in head to head games
3. points for/against in head to head games
4. points for in head to head games

### **Notes**

1. The BAA champion automatically receives the berth to CWOSSA
2. If a team (which is eligible for a qualifier game) decides to drop out; the next team eligible can take their place in the qualifier game.

For example:

SMHS is the highest ranking “A/AA” school from the north division and qualifies to play against KDSS in a qualifier game. However due to unforeseen reasons, SMHS cannot field a team. The second ranked “A/AA” school from the north division can take SMHS place in the qualifier game against KDSS.

3. League playoff games may also count as CWOSSA qualifier games.

For example:

“A/AA” south #1 beats “A/AA” north #2 in a league semi-final, but loses to “A/AA” north #1 in the final. “A/AA” north #1 goes to CWOSSA for winning the league, and so does “A/AA” south #1. “A/AA” south #1 would not need to replay the game against “A/AA” north #2 as they had previously beaten them in a semi-fina
