

B. A. A. PLAYING REGULATIONS BASKETBALL (BOYS AND GIRLS)

Dates:

Finals: Tuesday prior to C.W.O.S.S.A.

Semi-Finals and Crossover Games : To be played on the week prior to the week the Finals are being played.

League Games : Three games scheduled every two weeks up to playoff weeks.

The South Division play their league games on Monday and Wednesday, while the North Division play on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Locations:

Finals : Determined by the Odd-Even Format; that is: Winner of the Crossover Games (at South School on even numbered years and at North School on odd numbered years.)

Crossover Games :

Winner of 3rd at 2nd North Game at Winner of 4th at 1st South Game

Winner of 3rd at 2nd South Game at Winner of 4th at 1st North Game

Semi-Finals - In each division - 4th at 1st
3rd at 2nd

Eligibility :

Age eligibility for Junior and Senior classification will be as defined in the B.A.A. Constitution and By-Laws

Scheduling :

The schedule of each division is a home and home format .

Scheduled dates will be double-headers with junior and senior teams participating at each school involved, when both junior and senior teams are involved in league-play at both schools. If only one team is involved at one school; then there will only be a single game at the same age classification .

Game start times are 4:00 p.m.(Senior) and 5:30 p.m. (Junior). *. Any changes after this date must be by mutual consent of both schools involved . It is the responsibility of the home school to inform the convenor , assigning referee , the Sun Times and CFOS of all changes to the schedule . [* June 23 , 2005]

Half time shall be of eight minutes duration .

All teams must be scheduled to play all other teams once in their division before playing any school for a second time .

Semi-Finals - In each division - 4th at 1st

3rd at 2nd

Crossover Games :

Winner of 3rd at 2nd North Game at Winner of 4th at 1st South Game

Winner of 3rd at 2nd South Game at Winner of 4th at 1st North Game

Finals : Determined by the Odd-Even Format; that is: Winner of the Crossover Games (at South School on even numbered years and at North School on odd numbered years.)

Playing Rules / Officials :

Referees: The Grey-Bruce Referees Association will be used for all Bluewater District regular schedule and play-off games.

Game Times: The senior game will start at 4:00 p.m.. and the junior game at 5:30 p.m. unless the home team arranges to switch the senior-junior order of game times with the visiting team. In such cases the home team will inform the media.

When only one game is to played, it will start at 4:00 p.m.

If, in special circumstances, a different start time is arranged, the referees association, the convenor, and the media will be notified by the home team.

Scoring :

Each scheduled game won will receive one point

Awards :

The winner of the B.A.A. championship in each age classification will receive B.A.A. medallions as indicated in the B.A.A. Constitution and By-Laws.
