

B. A. A. PLAYING REGULATIONS FOOTBALL

Eligibility:

Eligibility as to age will conform with that of Senior as per the B.A.A. Constitution and By-Laws

Scheduling :

The regular season will follow a home and home format .

Playing Rules:

- a) The CTF Rule Book are the rules followed .
- b) There is no limit to the number of players used.
- c) Regular season games will start at 3:00 p.m.
- d) Play - off games will start at 2:00 p.m. (because of the time change)

Officials :

The home team is responsible for providing officials .

Scoring:

- a) For the regular season the scoring is as follows:
2 points for a win, 1 point for a tie. 0 points for a loss .
- b) Ties are not broken in regular season .
- c) During the play - offs , ties are broken by playing overtime .

Championship Structure:

- a) Games are played at the school of the higher placing team from the regular schedule .
- b) Semi - finals :
The top 4 teams will play - off with 1 st playing 4 th and 2 nd playing 3 rd .
- c) Finals :
The winners of the semi -final play - offs will play in the Final with the game being played at the school of the higher placed team .

Awards :

The championship team will receive B.A.A. Medallions and the B.A.A. plaque .

Advancement to Further Competition :

The B.A.A. champion will compete in the C.W.O.S.S.A. tournament .

Regular season is home. and home format

Top 4 teams will play off with 1st playing 4th and 2nd playing 3rd. Games are played

at the school, of the higherplacing team.

Winners of playoffs play in the Final with the game being played at the school of the higher placing team.

Start Times:

Regular season games start at.3 p m.

Playoff games start at 2p.m. (because of the time change)
